Natural Context

Stimulates spontaneous conversations and fosters the use of language functions such as requesting and questioning.

Vocabulary Growth

Each play scenario introduces new words that are relevant and meaningful, helping children acquire and retain language.

Pragmatics

Engaging in meaningful interactions require children to understand social cues, take others' perspectives, and adjust their communication style based on context.

Problem Solving
